

2020 OBSERVER INFORMATION GUIDE

Certified Observers are a key and valuable part of the Tournaments. To qualify you need to be certified by the IGFTO, IGFA or by the Los Sueños Observer Certification Program (LSOCP) and submit the Observer application form. Observers are selected on their fishing experience and by their physical ability to withstand three consecutive days on the water, as well as be situated in a location on the boat that properly allows them to follow all tournament-related activity.



MEALS

A light breakfast including eggs, gallo pinto (rice and beans) or potatoes, pastries, fresh fruit, juice, and coffee is served at the Hook Up each morning, starting at 5 am. Lunch is provided by the boats. Dinners are provided by the tournament (except Tuesday, January 14th).

OBSERVER COMPENSATION

To assist with some of your travel expenses, Observers will receive \$500 for observing for three consecutive fishing days during each leg of the Signature Triple Crown Series. If, for emergency reasons or at the request of the tournament committee, an observer is not assigned to a boat all three days, the pay for each individual day he/she observes is \$150. Observers that are assigned to a boat in the Ladies Only Tournament receive \$150 in compensation for the day of competition.
